

Fifth-largest economy in the world by 2030, according to global economic projections



Largest producer of essential metals for global supply chains, including nickel, copper, and aluminium



Strong government support for domestic manufacturing, creating a favorable business environment for foundry and metallurgy industries



Indonesia is home to the largest nickel reserves - mining is one of the country's most important sectors. In 2024, Indonesia's coal production hit a record 830 million tonnes. Meanwhile, Indonesia produced 54% of the world's nickel and was the sixth-largest copper producer in 2023.



Southeast Asia's largest consumer of steel and industrial metals, with projected consumption exceeding 25 million tonnes by 2026





In 2024, Indonesia opened Southeast Asia's first electric vehicle battery plant in the province of West Java. The plant is a result of a USD1 billion investment by a consortium comprising Hyundai Motor Group, LG Energy Solution, and the Indonesia Battery Corporation. Production capacity expansion is underway.



Indonesia has the eighth largest market size for forming of metal and powder metallurgy regionally, with demand reaching USD1.5 billion in 2023



Space Only

1. Walls : 2.44m high by 1m wide panels, 3mm thick plywood panels.


2. Facia : 30.5cm high, with exhibitor's name and stand number.
